Section A, B, C, D, PB & Ridden Champions & Reserve Champions will qualify for the SWA Welsh Champion of the year to be held on 10th September 2017 (Venue TBC). If the Champion &/or Reserve Champion has already qualified, the qualifier can go to the next pony but no lower than 3rd place. The two highest placed SWA members from classes 22&23 will also qualify for the above championship.

SWA members only – current membership badge to be worn in the ring.

NPAC Grand Prix Arenas Champion of Champions, Young Handler & Rider the Year Final.

The Champions of sections A, B, C, D & Welsh PB will qualify for the NPA of Cornwall Grand Prix Arenas Champion of the Year.

(If the champion has already qualified then qualification will pass to the reserve champion)

1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 22 -30 will qualify for the NPAC Grand Prix Arenas Rider of the Year final and Young Handler of the Year respectively.

(If 1st & 2nd have already qualified then qualification can pass to 3rd place)

Both the champion and reserve section WBPR will qualify for this championship. In the event of either having previously qualified, qualification will pass to 2nd reserve in the championship.

The highest placed gelding in classes 17-19 will be awarded Best Gelding rosettes. Recipients of these awards are eligible for The National Welsh Sarum Investments Ltd Gelding Championship & the SWA Gelding Championship.

SWA YOUNG HANDLER OF THE YEAR CLASSES

Judge: Ms S K Alexander-Ford - Tor-y-Myndd.

Class 22 : Young Handler, 7 – 11 years.

Class 23 : Young Handler, 12 – 16 years.

No stallions or colts in classes 22 & 23. Competitors aged 14 and under must wear a hard hat. The two highest placed SWA members in class 22 & 23 will qualify for SWA Handler of the Year.

SWA WELSH GELDING CHAMPIONSHIP

Best Gelding rosette winners from classes 1,2,3,5,6,7,9,10,11,13,14,15,17,18 & 19 are eligible.

Perpetual Millcroft Trophy to the Supreme Champion.

RIDDEN CLASSES

SWA Ring after Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Judge: Mrs T Hook – Kemysfawr.

Class 24: **Leading rein** up to 12 hh (122 cm), Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained 9th birthday before 1st January of the current year. (*Registered Pure Bred and Welsh Part Bred only, the highest placed A or B ponies and the highest placed WPBR will qualify for The National Welsh Brynseion Lead Rein Championship*)

Class 25: **First Ridden** up to 12.2 hh (128 cm), rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. (*Registered Pure Bred and Welsh Part Bred only, the highest placed A or B ponies and the highest placed WPBR will qualify for The National Welsh Brynseion First Ridden Championship*)

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP.

***1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 21 & 22 are eligible.
Perpetual Hothersall Trophy.***

Class 26: **Ridden Section A.** Mare, gelding or stallion.

Class 27: **Ridden Section B.** Mare, gelding or stallion.

Class 28: **Ridden Section C.** Mare, gelding or stallion.

Class 29: **Ridden Section D.** Mare, gelding or stallion.

Class 30: **Ridden Part-Bred.** Mare, gelding or stallion. Class may be split into over & under 148cms if entries permit. Two highest placed animals in each section will qualify for The National Welsh Ridden WPBR championship.

The two highest placed animals in classes 26 - 29 will qualify for The National Welsh Brynseion (A, B, C & D) Championship. No lead reins in classes 26 - 30.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Perpetual Clanfield Trophy.

1st & 2nd prize winners' classes 26 - 30 are eligible.

SUPREME RIDDEN WELSH CHAMPIONSHIP

**The Warner Perpetual Trophy kindly presented by The Warners
Champion & Reserve Champion from both Mini Championship & Ridden

***In Hand & Ridden Supreme & Reserve Supreme Champions are
eligible.***

RULES

1. The Organisers and Show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage from any cause or circumstances whatever to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property or any vehicle or otherwise brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Show.

2. The decision of the Judge is final and the Organisers reserve the right to amend the Judge's panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel/amalgamate any class with less than three entries.
4. The Committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
5. Any protest shall be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a deposit of £10. If the protest is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the show.
4. With the exception of the Part-Bred classes, all entries must be entered in the main section of the stud book for their respective breeds. Part Bred ponies must be registered in the Welsh Part-Bred register. Entries in the WPCS Section X of the Stud Book and Foundation Stock cannot compete but FS.1 and FS.2 may. **All stud book registration numbers must be given on all entry forms.**
7. Correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Spurs are not permitted and no cane to be more than 30 inches.
8. NO MANES OR TAILS TO BE PLAITED IN ANY M&M CLASS, OPTIONAL FOR PART-BREDS.
9. No nominations or substitutions will be made.
10. Ponies must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or officially leased.
11. No change of handler may be made once a class has commenced without the permission of the judge.
12. Stallions must be licensed in accordance with breed regulations.
13. The show committee strongly recommends that competitors have adequate third party insurance.
14. Competitors entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk, no entry fees will be refunded. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are ready to enter the ring at the appropriate time.
15. NPS rules regarding age of handlers/riders of stallions apply. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.
16. Ponies must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor or officially leased.
17. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
18. Exhibitors must not enter an animal when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in the animal, stud fee excluded, (the exhibitor being the owner, lessee or person producing and/or showing the animal). Judges may not adjudicate a pony which, to the judge's knowledge, is a pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his immediate family or employer.
19. Exhibitors are requested not to bring any coughing pony to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal.
20. All cups and trophies remain the property of the South Western Association of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society and must be returned to the show secretary. They may only be signed for by an adult SWA member ON RECEIPT OF A £10 DEPOSIT and remain the responsibility of the winner whilst in their possession. They may only be signed for and collected by an adult. Any person who has had an SWA cup or trophy in the past and has not returned it by the time of the next show may not be allowed to take away a cup or trophy they have won.
21. Refund of entry fee only on receipt of a veterinary certificate.
22. The Committee strongly recommends that competitors have adequate third party insurance.

PARENTS PLEASE BE AWARE that there may be photographers at the show and if you do not want your children photographed you must make your own arrangements. Only official photographers are allowed in the rings.
