

## SWA PERFORMANCE AWARDS COMPETITION RULES

1. The Competition will run from **1<sup>st</sup> November 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019**. Entry Fee of £4.00 per entry.
2. RETURN THE COMPLETED SCORE CARD NO LATER THAN **7<sup>th</sup> November 2019** to the Organiser: **Mrs Sara Glazebrook, Kingsland Cottage, Salway Ash, Bridport, Dorset DT6 5JF**. Please include a large SAE for rosettes if unable to attend the Awards – see Newsletter for date.
3. Open to stallions, mares and geldings of 4 years old and over, owned or officially leased by Members of the Association and registered in the Welsh Stud Book, the Appendix or the Part-Bred Register. Riders to be 3 yrs old and over.
4. If an entered pony/cob changes ownership during the year, points already earned may be transferred to the new owner provided they become a member of the Association and the Organiser is informed.
5. SHOWS/EVENTS TO QUALIFY FOR POINTS are:
  - those held in CORNWALL, DEVON, DORSET, SOMERSET, and 3 other shows anywhere in the country.
  - NO MORE THAN 25 SHOWS/EVENTS AND ONLY 3 CLASSES (excluding championships) PER DAY.
  - Shows affiliated to NPS/BSPS/WPCS//PUK/BE/BS/BD/BDS/CHAPS, are to earn an extra 5 points. All others are classified as unaffiliated including South West Ponies Association.
  - South Western Association Shows qualify for DOUBLE POINTS plus one other show/event chosen by the competitor.
6. The Competition is for all 5 Sections of the Welsh Stud Book with placings 1 to 6 in Sections A, B, C, D and Part Bred but 1 to 10 in the overall results. Perpetual trophies will be awarded annually to: the Overall winner, the first prize winner in each Section, most versatile, best novice, most 1<sup>st</sup> prizes, best gelding, and the most straight ridden showing points (Code RSC). All cups and trophies remain the property of the Association for which a £10 deposit is required and are the responsibility of the recipient whilst in their care. Every returned entry will receive a rosette if not in the placings. Special rosettes will be awarded for the categories listed on the following page.
7. THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE **NOT** ELIGIBLE FOR POINTS: In Hand, Best Rider, Equitation, Best Senior/Junior Whip, Best Turned Out, Concours d'Elegance, Gymkhana, Pairs, Best Combination, Team placings or Highest Placed Awards, Clear Round Jumping and Fancy Dress.

## **Notes**

- \* Leading rein to cover all led competitions. Extra points for show jumping etc, may not be claimed
- \*\* One Day events – 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> placing – add 5 points
- \*\*\*Graded Rides/Drives - either place points or bonus points to count not both
- \*\*\*Horse Trials- only final complete placing to count not placing in individual phases unless separate competition.

## **Bonus Points**

- Pleasure/sponsored/endurance rides or drives; hunting - 5 points per day
- PC/RC Rallies or Clinics: representing club, qualifying for Regional or national championship - 1 point
- Champion – 8 points - Reserve Champion – 6 points (championships to be counted as separate class in addition to the 3 classes per day rule)
- Supreme Champion – 10 points/Reserve Supreme – 8 points (championships to be counted as separate class in addition to the 3 classes per day rule)

## **Special Rosettes**

In addition to a special rosette for the youngest competitor in Sections A, B, C, D and Part Bred, and where there is no trophy, special rosettes will be awarded to the pony/cob with the highest points where there is three or more competitors in the following:

1. (WHP) Working Hunter Pony
2. (LDR) Leading Rein
3. (CFP) First Ridden
4. (SJA) Showjumping
5. (DRE) Dressage
6. (COM/EVO/EVT/HTR) Best Combined Training/ 2/3/1 Day Event/Hunter Trial/Tetrathlon
7. (PCP/PCR) Best Pony Club/Riding Club
8. (HFP) Best Handy Pony/Le Trec/RC/PC Pony
9. (RAD) Driving (Pleasure/Private/Ride & Drive)
