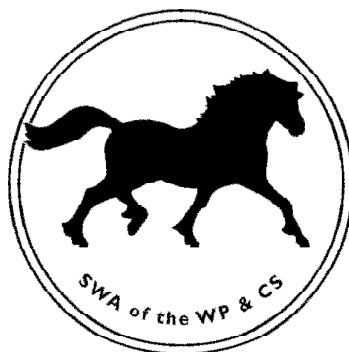

DIRECTIONS TO HYPERION EC

Exit A38 at Kennford Services. Go through village of Kennford and follow road as it turns north and crosses back over the A38. Immediately after crossing the bridge turn left towards Clapham. Keep straight on past the 'CLAPHAM' sign and turn left to Underdown and after about a quarter of a mile Hyperion EC is on the right.

Class 11: Part-Bred – 1,2,3 yr old colt, filly or gelding and foals at foot
Class 12: Part-Bred – 4 yrs old and over**

RIDDEN CLASSES
(to follow on from in hand classes)

Class 13: Registered Welsh pure-bred or Welsh part-bred leading rein mare or gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 12 hh. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their ninth birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 14: Registered Welsh pure-bred or Welsh part-bred first ridden mare or gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 12.2 hh. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 15: Welsh Section A

Class 16: Welsh Section B

Class 17: Welsh Section C

Class 18: Welsh Section D

Class 19: Welsh Part Bred (best under 13.2 hh and best over 13.2 hh to qualify)

Welsh Champion of the Year finals will take place after 11.00 am (Entry Fee of £8.00 to be paid to Secretary prior to entry into Final). Where there are less than 3 entries in any class, the Secretary reserves the right to amalgamate classes where appropriate. However, the highest placed animal of each Stud Book Section will still qualify.

PERPETUAL CUPS AND TROPHIES

Please note that trophies can only be taken by SWA members on receipt of a £10 per cup or trophy. The deposit is refundable when the trophy is returned in the same condition in which it was received. Trophies must be returned a month before the following year's show.

RULES

1. The Organisers and each of the Show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Show.
2. Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing to the Show Secretary and shall at the same time deposit the sum of £10. If on investigation by the Show Committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the Show. All protests shall be delivered within half an hour of the incident.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the Judge's Panel and Order of Classes if it should become necessary.
4. All entries must be entered in the A, B, C, D or Welsh Part-Bred Register Mountain & Moorland classes, their Part-Breds and Driving classes. Animals registered in the Welsh Section X of the Stud Book and Foundation Stock cannot compete but FS.1 and FS.2 may. ***All registration numbers must be given on the entry form.***
5. Relevant classes are eligible for points towards the Welsh Pony & Cob Society Performance Award Scheme, the South Western Association Performance, In Hand and Young Adult In Hand Award Competitions.
6. The Committee reserves the right to cancel/amalgamate any Class with less than three entries.
7. The Committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the Show being cancelled.
8. **NO MANES OR TAILS OF PURE BREDS TO BE PLAITED IN ANY M&M CLASS – IT IS OPTIONAL FOR PART BREDS.**

9. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are ready to enter the ring at the appropriate time.
10. Ponies must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor or officially leased.
11. Riders must wear correctly secured current British Standards skull caps/riding hats at all times when mounted. Spurs are not permitted. Showing canes can be no more than 30 inches long.
12. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
13. Exhibitors should not enter an animal when that animal will be judged by a person who is the breeder or who has had a financial interest in the animal.
14. NO nominations or substitutions will be permitted.
15. Exhibitors are requested not to bring any coughing pony to the Show and may be requested to remove any such animal at the Veterinary Officer's discretion.
16. All cups and trophies remain the property of the South Western Association of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society and must be returned to the Show Secretary. Only SWA members may take a cup or trophy and they may only be signed for and collected by an adult SWA member ON RECEIPT OF A £10 DEPOSIT which will be retained should the cup not be returned. Trophies are the responsibility of the winner whilst in their possession. Any person who has had a SWA cup or trophy in the past and has not returned it by the time of the next show may not be allowed to take away any cup or trophy that they have been awarded.
17. Colts and stallions to be licensed in accordance with Breed Society rules.
18. No change of rider/handler will be allowed throughout the class without the judge's permission.
19. Exhibitors entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk, no entry fees will be refunded.
20. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
21. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.
22. The show committee strongly recommends that competitors have adequate third party insurance.

PARENTS PLEASE BE AWARE that there will be official photographers at this show and if you do not want your children photographed you must make your own arrangements. Only the official photographers are allowed in the rings.
